Schedule and Cost

The event begins Friday evening with dinner and continues through Sunday with morning worship, departing after lunch. Total cost of the event is \$155 and includes tuition, cabin housing for two nights and all meals. If you choose to stay in the semi-private lodge rooms, cost is \$165, and there is maximum space for 40 guests. Also, if you need financial assistance, scholarships are often available through local churches.
